CONCEPTION:

The love for the motherland brought the founder's Mrs & Mr. F.D. ELIAS in the year 1950 from England to India. Their sole purpose was THEIR vision to add their mite and their expertise to the growth of a nation by educating the Naunihals irrespective of class or creed - To make them spiritually, morally, physically and mentally strong, for they believed that the rise & fall of a nation solely depends on the shoulders of the young citizens. The establishment of the parent institution viz THE MODEL SCHOOL FOR INFANTS, was a small step towards that aim and vision.

THE VISION:

The years saw the partial fulfillment of the vision. **THE MODEL HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL** a vision partly fulfilled. The yester years saw the hard labour and the toil with which the founder have brought these educational institution to an educational level which has become a cynosure of the educational world.

TRANSFORMATION OF VISION TO PHYSICAL FORM:

The aim of the college is to impart total education to each student irrespective of class or creed. The scope of the education imparted, ranges from academics, to neglected areas, like the development of personality, talent and healthy social interaction.

The Institution aims at grooming the student to be a good citizen of our mother-land by inculcating in them discipline, dedication and sound moral values. Special emphasis is given to spoken English but in no way is the mother tongue Hindi sidelined. The core concept is the emphasis of wisdom over knowledge.

LOCATION:

The school is located in the zero pollution, peaceful, lush green, picturesque and quiet areas of civil lines. The locality provides a healthy and fresh atmosphere for the children to grow up. The School has a spacious campus with adequate playground and hygienic canteen facilities.

PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION:

Admission & Registrations commences from Jan/February each year for all classes.

1. At the time of the admission student must produce transfer certificate of the previous school for class first upwards & for Class Nur. & KG. a valid date of birth certificate is required.
2. The Admission written test will be conducted for classes first upwards, in order to assess a child for English, Hindi, Maths, Science & G.K.
3. The school authority reserves the right to admission of a student even after having tested and declared eligible.
4. It is to be noted that registration does not mean admission.



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TEST:

1. At least 50% aggregate marks are necessary for eligibility for entrance test, in the last qualifying examination.
2. Certificate of good conduct from previous institution.

RULES FOR EXAMINATION AND PROMOTIONS

1. The school academic year starts in April.
2. Any pupil whose attendance falls below 75% or who is lacking in regularity, punctuality and in-completion of work will not be allowed to sit for the promotion test unless previous permission has been granted by the principal.
3. Make up test will not be given for being absent on any ground. In case of illness, pupils general performance will be taken into consideration.
4. The promotion of a child will depend on the average marks of periodical test results and the annual examination.
5. If periodical report shows that a pupil has failed in a certain subject, the parents must consult the teacher concerned through the principal after seeking appointment.

THE SCHOOL YEAR IS DIVIDED INTO THREE TERMS:

FIRST TERM	:	May to September
SECOND TERM	:	October to December
THIRD TERM	:	January to March

There are regular monthly test conducted apart from the terminal and the final examination.

Monthly Parents/teachers meetings are held regularly.

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

Games and physical training are regular features under the supervision of experienced physical training instructors, cultural activities are also encouraged on Saturday tutorials are conducted free of cost.

VACATION AND HOLIDAYS:

Mid May to end of June : Summer Vacation

Only gazetted and important holidays are included in the school calendar.

FEE STRUCTURE AND RULES:

1. The school follows monthly fee structure and separate rules in the Cash Receipts is followed. 12 months fee is chargeable in all cases.
2. The principal reserves the right of revising all rates of school fee and conveyance fee at any time with or without any notice.
3. Conveyance seat is reserved for the session.
4. School fee and the Conveyance fee is non-refundable.



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

1. All students are expected to join on the opening –three days of the session and after each vacation. Those students who are absent without prior leave approval would be considered absent. Continuous absence there of for ten days will result in their names being struck off from the rolls.
2. Students must reach school at least five minutes before bell time. Late comers will be fined/punished.
3. Taking home of the students during school time by the parents is discouraged.
4. Students must behave properly on their way to and from school.
5. The school reserves the right to suspend, expel and rusticate a student whose conduct or behaviour is unsatisfactory.
6. All students must be in their proper school uniform and neatness in their uniforms is a must. White sports uniform should be worn on very Friday.
7. To make the student proficient in English – English speaking must be encouraged at home.
8. Damages done to the school property must be paid for by the student responsible or Fines may be imposed by the Principal for breaches against regularity, discipline and loss of school property.
9. All students must have their names and classes written on their personal belongings which they bring to school, for proper.

RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS

1. Politeness & courtesy of speech and conduct should be inculcated in the child along with the sense of cleanliness of dress & person.
2. Parents are requested not to send for or call away their children during the class hours except incase of unforeseen emergency.
3. Reports and recommendation from the teacher and the principal should be signed by the parents.
4. Parents should arrange to take their children home within 30 minutes after the school is over, otherwise school will not be responsible.
5. Teachers may be met after seeking appointment through the principal.
6. Parents should be particular that their wards take all exams & tests. (unless the pupil is sick for which a medical certificate should be given).
7. Parents are requested to attend parents teachers meeting regularly for discussing there Child's progress.
